The Central Sierra Resiliency Fund is hosting a Community Soil Stabilization Demonstration and Training Clinic this coming Saturday, October 24th at 1:00 pm with Chris Velez, Board Member of People Food and Land Foundation and native plant expert at Intermountain Nursery and Juli Stewart, Forester, Resiliency Council Member and Owner of Vermilion Resource Management to help private landowners better understand the soil stabilization methods available to stop land erosion.

Participants of the clinic will be trained in beginning soil stabilization techniques using rice hay. Community members are welcome to join, but are encouraged to wear close toed shoes, work clothes and bring gloves and masks with them. NRCS (USDA Natural Resource Conservation Service) will also be present to field additional questions regarding soil stabilization methods.
